FOOD AND BEVERAGE

- Taking food tickets.
- Serving food and beverages.
- Must be able to stand for long periods of time.
- The concession-stand is located inside the dance hall, so you must be able to tolerate the music.

FARWELL/GOODNIGHT

- Friendly/Goodbye (handing out souvenirs) etc.

CLEAN-UP CREW

- Must stay from 12:00 AM to 1:00 AM to clean up all areas for prom.
- Includes taking down all decorations and clean off all tables.

SALES/FUNDRAISING

- Sell programs ads.
- Secure sponsors and underwriters for prom
- Solicit prizes for Gay Prom
- Special events, auctions, raffles, etc.
- Promote advance ticket sales (discount ticket sales for groups 10 or more)

SECURITY/DOOR MONITORS

- Make sure the prom goers all have a wrist band.
- Check all purses and bags
- May need to escort prom goers to their cars

THE SMALLEST, TINIEST, MOST SUBTLE BIT OF POLICY

Volunteers must not have outstanding warrants or criminal court cases.
 No sexual/intimate relationships between volunteers and youth working and/or attending Gay Prom.
 Youth confidentiality must be maintained at all times.
 No alcohol or drug use during any volunteer activities or at Gay Prom.
 Formal or dressy attire is requested inside Gay Prom (Carnival Room service providers excluded).
 Provide safe and respectful event for all attendees, media, community members and staff.
 First time volunteers must attend Orientation Meeting. (see details below).
